

Description	<p>The Eric Singleton Bird Sanctuary is an artificial wetland in Bayswater, Western Australia, a suburb of Perth.</p> <p>The wetlands were named after Eric Singleton, who was a local advocate for the wetlands. He was a bird enthusiast and helped save the wetlands from development in the 1970s.</p>

Evacuation Plan	<p>If urgent call 000 and follow advice from the emergency services.</p> <p>Ambulatory – Assist them to walk back to the car park for collection, via the quickest/easiest route.</p> <p>Litter – Using able adults within the group to stretch back to the car parks OR call 000 & wait for assistance.</p> <p>Spinal – DO NOT MOVE, secure in locations await emergency services.</p> <p>Minor ailments, treat in-situ try to prevent & treat items before they escalate.</p>		
Communications Plan	<p>Primary – Mobile (Ollie 0411 092 033)</p> <p>Secondary – Runner</p> <p>Emergency – Mobile</p>		

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Mobile communication is typically decent throughout the walk. - UHF radios should maintain communications with the car park throughout, if brought. - Runners can be employed to the car park, a person at a brisk pace can be back with 10 minutes from any point on the route. - A check in time will be set, that if we have not checked in by this time to escalate.
<p>Notes for teachers</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - No water on site, will need to be brought in with us. - Guide will check BOM for weather & current environmental warnings on the lead up & during the activity. Alternative locations or cancellation may be advised. - All participants need: Sun hats, shirts, trousers or shorts to walk in (Weather dependant, no jeans), practical shoes to walk in, water bottle (Min 1L). - Teachers will need to supply in advance information about their participants including; physical ability, allergies, medical conditions & other items that may impact an individuals ability to participate. This information will be used by the lead guide to best tailor the experience. - The guide in addition will have: First aid kit, mobile phone, emergency response plans. - Students need to be easily identified (High vis vests, school uniform shirts) - Note Toilets are located at the riverside garden toilets.
